General Rules and Information:

- 1 2013 Rule book revisions are now available to attach to your rule books. It is your responsibility to know the rules of your events! Contact membership director Jill Polhemus (bpjg@aol.com) for a rule book. Updates and 2013 revisions are available online. Visit [www.ncjra.com](http://www.ncjra.com)
- 2 All-Around buckles will be awarded to the All-Around Jr Girl, Jr Boy, All-Around Sr Girl, Sr Boy.
- 3 Payback will be at least 50% of the entry fee in each event. No money Payback for Pee Wee and Jr/Jr (6-9) events All ties will be broken by flip of a coin. Jr/Jr (6-9) & Family Team Roping events do not count towards NCJRA points or All Around. SINGLE STAKE WILL COUNT TOWARD ALL-AROUND POINTS AT THIS RODEO
- 4 Payback will be determined according to the number of entries as follows: under 5 entries - 60/40, 5 to 10 entries - 50/30/20, 11-15 entries - 40/30/20/10, over 15 entries - 30-25-20-15-10.
- 5 Entry form MUST be accompanied by entry fee and signed release form. Parent or legal guardian MUST sign release. Each contestant is limited to one (1) entry per event. Current NCJRA rules will be followed. Contestants must sign in for contestant numbers. NO REFUNDS for Turn Outs
- 6 All contestants must wear western hats, boots and long-sleeved shirts TUCKED in. Sleeves MUST be rolled down to the cuff. Rough Stock riders - Protective gear shall be worn (mouthpiece, vest, helmet / face mask) Contestant numbers MUST be worn when competing.
- 7 Contestants must be prepared to show proof of age on request if not a member of NCJRA. A separate entry blank must be submitted for each contestant including Jr/Jr (6-9) contestants. Contestants who enter Jr/Jr (6-9) events may **NOT** participate in any other event.
- 8 Ropers/Team Ropers: You are responsible for making sure that your partner enters. If your partner does not enter, you will not be entered, and your entry fee will be refunded after the rodeo or when time permits. You are required to state on the entry blank whether YOU are a Header or Heeler. Family Team Ropers: A Jr Rodeo contestant may enter ONCE with a parent, grand parent legal guardian, or family member 25 years or older. Calf Ropers: Horses MUST have neck rope.
- 9 All Contestants who have not paid membership fees for 2013 to the NCJRA Northern California Junior Rodeo Association are required to pay the \$15.00 permit fee. Jr/Jr's must pay the office fee & ambulance fee, not the permit fee. Pee Wees pay the office fee, not the ambulance fee or permit fee.
