2019 Clements Jr Stampede Royalty

Rules & Expectations

1. I understand the contestant age requirements and understand all ages are as of January 1, 2019:
 - a. Miss Jr Stampede, Ages 13 – 18
 - b. Little Miss Jr Stampede Ages 8 – 12
2. Contestants must not have previously held the title for which they are running.
3. All Contestants must submit a completed application packet by the application deadline of 05/01/2019. (Bring it with you to Orientation)
4. All Contestants must submit four 8x10 'head & shoulders' photos wearing western attire and a western hat with their application. These photos will be used for newspapers and other promotions at the discretion of the Clements Buckaroos.
5. All Contestants are required to attend the Royalty Orientation on 05/01/2019, at 6:30 p.m. at the Clements Buckaroo Clubhouse, 19813 E. Hwy 88 in Clements. Please dress to impress!
6. All Contestants are required to ride a mandatory horsemanship pattern which will be provided by the Royalty Committee at orientation. Judging will be based on horsemanship, proper execution of pattern and equitation, not best horse. Competition shall take place on 06/01/2019 at the Sliding J Ranch on 24860 N Tully Rd, Acampo. Riders must be on property by 7:30 am. Competition will begin at 8:30 am. Contestants will be asked to complete a rail class as well.
7. For the mandatory pattern riders must wear a plain, unadorned, solid-colored, long sleeve button up shirt, blue jeans, western hat & boots for western riders. A helmet is acceptable.

8. Each Contestant will be required to complete the following in addition to horsemanship:
 - a. Written test. (Horsemanship Day)
 - b. Personal interview with the judges (Horsemanship and Speech Days)
 - c. Answer impromptu 'knowledge' & 'personality' questions (Speech Day)
 - d. Speech 3-5 minutes (Speech Day), Little Miss will only be required to give a 1-minute-long speech
 - e. Tack ID (Speech Day)
9. Poise and personality are important as you will be representing organizations and sponsors in your community. You will be asked to present a speech on a topic given to you at orientation. Speeches will be given during the banquet on 06/01/2019 19813 E. Hwy 88 in Clements, CA
10. Attire for interview/speech/banquet: Contestants should dress like an equestrian professional (example, Western dress, or skirt & long sleeve blouse, western boots). Short dresses, mini-skirts and evening wear are not appropriate.
11. One Miss and one Little Miss Jr Stampede will be chosen. The size of the court may be changed at the discretion of the Jr Stampede Royalty Committee.
12. Each Contestant must submit a \$25.00 application fee (checks payable to Clements Buckaroos) with their application and head shot.
13. Each Contestant will be required to sell at least 10 banquet tickets to qualify for the title. Contestants are encouraged to sell as many tickets as possible.
14. Each Contestant may also earn points by selling 50/50 tickets. Each contestant will be required to sell 100, \$1.00 raffle tickets to earn full points in the tickets sale category. Contestants may sell more, to be eligible for the title of highest ticket sales, but will not earn more points.
15. Our Royalty will be asked to attend events in a wide variety of venues, including local parades and community events. You will also be called upon to assist in selling tickets for fundraising events and to attend local equestrian related events.

16. Miss and Little Miss Jr Stampede will be required to attend at least 6 of the events listed on the 2019 Upcoming Events page.
17. All Contestants agree to abide by all regulations set forth by the Clements Jr Stampede Royalty Committee and/or the Clements Buckaroos Board of Directors.
18. A 'secret' judge will be attending various portions of the competition. He/she will be looking for sportsmanship, humane treatment of animals, etc.
19. If you receive a perpetual crown or sash, you agree to maintain proper care of the item and to return it when requested before the date of the coronation of the 2020 royalty.

Contestant Contract

1. I will, at all times, abide by the regulations set forth by the Clements Jr Stampede Rodeo Committee and the Clements Buckaroos Association.
2. I will at all times strive to represent good sportsmanship, high moral and ethical character, and endorse humane treatment of animals.
3. If I become the 2019 Miss Clements Jr Stampede, I promise to make myself available for photographic and interview opportunities and to appear as 2019 Clements Jr Stampede Royalty to promote the Clements Buckaroos, the Jr Stampede, and other events and sponsors as needed by the Clements Buckaroos.
4. During the competition and/or after becoming the 2019 Clements Stampede Royalty, I agree to hold a high standard of moral and ethical behavior befitting of my title and to set a good example for our youth, to the public and to future competitors.
5. I promise not to participate in or conduct myself in any manner unbecoming of a Queen or Princess, (such as smoking drinking alcohol, bad manners, disrespecting parents or other adults, inhumane treatment of animals, etc.).
6. I agree not to use inappropriate language or get involved in any inappropriate conversations on any social media networks such as Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. Furthermore, I agree to give the members of the Jr Stampede Committee and/or the Clements Buckaroos access to these accounts.
7. I understand, if I am found to be in violation, it may result in forfeiture of my title as well as forfeiture of all prizes and gifts given to me by sponsors, the Committee, or the Clements Buckaroos.
8. If I am crowned Miss or Little Miss Clements Jr Stampede 2019 and have the title revoked or give up the title, for any reason, I understand I forfeit all

rights to prizes given to me by sponsors, the Clements Buckaroos, or the Clements Buckaroos Jr Stampede Committee.

9. I agree to return all perpetual property before the next contest (or I may be charged for the item(s) not returned). This includes, but not limited to crown, leather sashes, etc.

10. Contestants for Miss Jr Stampede 2019 must be single females, having never been married and never been pregnant between the ages of 14 and 18 as of January 1, 2019 and between the ages of 8-13 for LMCJS.

11. I have carefully read the aforementioned Clements Jr Stampede 2019 Royalty Contestant Contract (#1 -10) and accompanying Waiver of Liability, and fully understand its contents and agree to abide by the terms and conditions contained within.

Rules and Regulations

1. Contestants must submit the following documents in order to compete in the contest.
 - a. Miss Clements Stampede Queen Contestant Application Form.
 - b. Agreement to Abide by Rules and Regulations and Waiver of Liability.
 - c. Expectation Agreement.
 - d. Required Appearances Agenda. All documents must be signed by both the contestant and parent/guardian and be properly completed in order to be eligible for consideration.
2. Contestants must conduct them-self in a lady-like manner, portray high moral standards and good “sportsmanship” at all times or risk disqualification.
3. Contestants must have a suitable horse to use for the rodeo and other related events, but it need not be the horse used in the contest.
4. Contestants are required to be on time and adhere to the schedule of the contest.
5. Contestants are responsible for their own transportation to and from the contest, rodeo, and other related events and they must be able to provide their own wardrobe.
6. Only members of the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Committee, Contestants, and Judges are permitted in the arena during competition.
7. If any problems occur, i.e., a tack failure or a thrown shoe from the horse, the contestants should stop their pattern immediately and go directly to the judges in order to solve the problem. If the contestant experiences any problems, yet still completes the pattern, the matter will not be considered.
8. Final decision will be that of the judges including any matters that may arise while the contestant is competing.
9. All contestants are required to dress in western attire.
10. Contestants are not permitted at any time during the contest or as reigning queen to drink alcoholic beverages, smoke or use foul language while making public appearances.
11. Upon arrival at the location of the contest, contestants will be responsible to and under the jurisdiction of the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Committee.
12. Parents, friends and relatives are welcome to attend any or all activities designated and must agree to abide by all rules and regulations.

13. The perpetual crown and chaps are the permanent property of the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Committee.
14. Any problems that should arise should be directed to the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Committee
15. While you are Queen, you may not compete for another Rodeo Queen title unless prior approval is given.
16. No appearances are to be made at any function without prior consent of the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Queen Coordinator.
17. After the coronation, each contestant, including the new Queen, is expected to remain at the event location and to demonstrate good behavior and sportsmanship. It is appropriate for contestants, as well as the new Queen, to show their appreciation for the opportunity to compete by thanking judges, sponsors, Junior Rodeo Queen Committee members and other Association officials who may be present, for their efforts to support and organize the event.
18. Any misconduct may be grounds for contestants to be ineligible for this contest or future contests.
19. Any violations of these Rules and Regulations may disqualify a contestant from participation in this contest.
20. If for any reason the 2019 Miss Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Queen cannot perform all the required duties, the 2019 "1st Runner-Up" will be awarded the honor. If for any reason the 2019 "1st Runner- Up" cannot perform all the required duties, the 2019 "2nd Runner- Up" will be awarded the honor.

Note:

These rules and regulations are designed for your safety and to keep the contest running properly and in a professional manner. If any grievances arise, either during or after the contest, the matter should be brought to the attention of the Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Queen Committee.

 - a. Mounting and dismounting.
 - b. Pleasant presentation.
 - c. Riding skills (balance, calm hands, good seat).

 - a. Cleanliness and condition of horse.
 - b. Knowledge of your horse.
7. TACK – Judging is based on the following:
 - a. Cleanliness and condition.
 - b. General knowledge of tack.
8. IMPROMTU– Personality and Poise
9. Test
 - a. Equine Knowledge
 - b. Rodeo Knowledge
 - c. Personality
10. 50/50 RAFFLE TICKET
 - a. Girls are required to Sell 100 50/50 Raffle tickets Cost: \$1.00
 - b. Full points awarded to completion of sales.
 - c. Selling more than 100 tickets will put you in the running for highest

ticket sales, but will not earn more points than allotted.

6. I will wear my banner, crown and proper western attire whenever I make public appearances as "Queen".
7. I will represent Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo at many local functions and fundraisers. (schedule attached)
8. I am not expected to make appearances during school hours unless approved by my parents. I will also adhere to a 9:00 pm curfew for events.
9. I will keep in close contact with my coordinator(s) and will notify them if I am unable to meet any of my obligations as Queen or if any problems arise.
10. If I am unable to fulfill my duties as Queen or if I do not adhere to this Expectation

Agreement, I agree to forfeit my title as Queen and return all Clements Stampede Junior Rodeo Committee property and all prizes I received.
