Miss Clements Buckaroos Rules and Regulations

1. Application must be received or postmarked by January 1, 2025. There will be no applications accepted after January 1, 2024 unless approved by the Miss Clements Buckaroos Queen Committee.
2. Orientation day is January 11, 2024 at 9am at the Clements Buckaroos Rodeo Grounds.
3. Ripon Almond Blossom Parade will be the first appearance for the contestants.
4. This pageant is open to girls ranging in age from 6 to 26 years of age (age as of March 18th, 2023 Coronation day) and is divided into 4 categories: Remember this is NOT a beauty pageant nor a clothing competition
 - a. Little Miss: Ages 6 to 10 years (Little Miss queens can run again in the little Miss age bracket if they are within the age bracket, but not consecutive years.)
 - b. Junior Miss: Ages 11 to 13 years
 - c. Teen Miss: Ages 14 to 17 years
 - d. Miss: Ages 18 to 26 years

*exceptions of the age rule can be made if a potential contestant, parent and the pageant director feel that she is either not ready for an age group or is ready for an older age group, ultimately decided by the Queen Committee.
5. Current title holders of other associations may compete if their reign ends 2 weeks after the Miss Clements Buckaroos Coronation.
6. Each contestant and their parent/guardian (if under 18 years of age) must sign a release of liability prior to participation.
7. The Non-Refundable application fee is \$25.00 and due when the application is turned in by the date specified. Make Checks Payable to Clements Buckaroos.
8. All applicants must uphold their title with respect, honor, grace, integrity and dignity. Applicants will not involve themselves in any activities that bring dishonor to the title, contest, queen committee or fellow applicants. If asked to remove or edit media included on one's social media presence in conflict with the standards set forth by the Miss Clements Buckaroos Queen Committee, applicants will comply and do so.
9. Cell phone use will not be tolerated during the competition or while out in the community representing Miss Clements Buckaroos and the Clements Buckaroos.
10. Contestant must be born female, single, never have married or entered into a marriage agreement that was annulled nor have been or currently be pregnant.
11. Decisions made by the judges are final. In the case of a tie the winner of horsemanship will be crowned queen.
12. Contestants are required to sell 300- \$1 raffle tickets and 10 dinner tickets.

13. Contestants will be required to provide their own sound mount at all events that require a mount. If the mount is unsound at the time of horsemanship, the contestant will be provided with a horse from the queen committee.
14. Contestants will be judged in 4 different categories:
 - a. Horsemanship (35%)
 - b. Personal Interview (25%)
 - c. Speech (30%)
 - d. Appearance (10%)
15. Horsemanship: Each Contestant will be required to do a reining pattern and queen's wave.
 - a. Teen and Miss contestants will be required to do a reining pattern, queen's wave, flag run, and draw horse.
 - b. If available the Teen and Miss contestants may be required to work a cow.
- 16. NO STALLIONS ARE ALLOWED!!!**
17. Any unsportsmanship like conduct by any **CONTESTANT AND/OR FAMILY MEMBER** will result in immediate disqualification.
18. Awards from the contest are considered property of the Miss Clements Buckaroos Queen Committee until the full year of when the crown is past down and will be relinquished by the contestant/Queen in the event of a disqualification/removal of title.
19. Title winners **MUST** attend functions as a group or individually, representing Miss Clements Buckaroos and Clements Buckaroos, when asked by the pageant committee and/or The Clements Buckaroos.
20. Title Holders will be required to attend all Clements Buckaroos events unless prior plans or emergency has come up. Title holders must let the queen coordinator know immediately if this is a factor.
21. Any harassment of the pageant committee, rodeo committee, judges or other contestants by another contestant or her family will be considered grounds for disqualification from the competition or removal of a title.
22. Title winners will remain unmarried and must not have a child or become pregnant during their reign. This will be immediate ground for removal of title and **ALL AWARDS**.
23. The Miss Clements Buckaroos chaps are perpetual and the property of the Miss Clements Buckaroos Committee and The Clements Buckaroos. They must be kept in good condition during the reign of the Miss, Junior, Young and the Little Queen. If they are not, they must be replaced at the expense of the title owner. They must be relinquished at the end of her reign or at the request of the Miss Clements Buckaroos Committee.
