## Miss Clements Stampede Rules and Regulations

1. Orientation Day is June 13, 2026 at 9:00 AM at the Clements Buckaroos Rodeo Grounds.
2. This pageant is open to girls ranging in age from 6 to 25 years of age (age as of September 12, 2026, Coronation Day) and is divided into 4 categories. **This is not a beauty pageant nor a clothing competition.**
  - Little Miss: Ages 6 to 9 years. (Little Miss queens may run again in the Little Miss category if they are within the age bracket, but not in consecutive years.)
  - Junior Miss: Ages 10 to 13 years.
  - Teen Miss: Ages 14 to 17 years.
  - Miss: Ages 18 to 25 years.

*\*Exceptions to the age guidelines may be made if a potential contestant, parent/guardian, and the pageant director agree the contestant is ready for an older age group. The Queen Committee will make the final determination.*

3. Contestants will be judged in 5 categories:
  - Horsemanship (30%)
  - Personal Interview (20%)
  - Speech (30%)
  - Appearance (10%)
  - Written Test (10%) – Jr. Miss, Teen Miss, and Miss divisions.
4. Horsemanship: Each contestant will be required to perform a reining pattern and a queen wave.
  - Teen Miss and Miss contestants will be required to perform a reining pattern, queen wave, flag run, and draw pattern.
  - If available, Teen Miss and Miss contestants may be required to work a cow.
  - No stallions are allowed.
5. Current title holders of other associations may compete if their reign ends at least 2 weeks after the Miss Clements Stampede Coronation on September 12, 2026.
6. Each contestant and their parent/guardian (if under 18 years of age) must sign a release of liability prior to participation.
7. The \$50 non-refundable application fee is due when the application is submitted by the specified deadline. A \$10 late fee applies to any applications postmarked after June 1, 2026. Make checks payable to Clements Buckaroos, Inc.
8. An 8" x 10" color headshot in Western attire must be submitted with the application.
9. All contestants and title holders must uphold their role with **respect, honor, integrity, and dignity**. Contestants and title holders shall not participate in any activities that bring dishonor to the title, the contest, the Queen Committee, the Clements Buckaroos, or fellow contestants.

10. If a contestant or title holder is asked to remove or edit any media on their social media platforms that conflict with the standards set forth by the Miss Clements Stampede Queen Committee, the contestant must comply promptly.
11. Cell phone usage should be kept to a minimum while representing Miss Clements Stampede and the Clements Buckaroos in the community.
12. Title holders must be able to fulfill all duties, appearances, and obligations of the position throughout the entirety of their reign. Any title holder who becomes unable to fulfill the responsibilities of the role—for any reason—may be subject to review by the Queen Committee, which may result in a reassignment of duties or removal of title. The Queen Committee will make this determination on a case-by-case basis.
13. Decisions made by the judges are final. In the case of a tie, the contestant with the highest horsemanship score will be crowned.
14. There is an essay award for the Miss and Teen Miss categories. Please attach an essay with your application on the topic: *“The Western way of life is diminishing as we know it. What ways as a Clements Stampede representative would I help promote the Western way of life?”*
15. Contestants are required to sell 500 raffle tickets (\$1 each), 10 dinner tickets, and \$300 in ad space for programs.
16. Contestants are required to provide their own sound and suitable horse for all events requiring a mounted appearance.
17. Any unsportsmanlike conduct by a contestant and/or their family members may result in immediate disqualification.
18. Awards from the contest remain the property of Clements Buckaroos, Inc. and the Miss Clements Stampede Queen Committee until the completion of the reigning year and the crowning of the next title holder. In the event of disqualification or removal of title, all awards must be immediately returned by the title holder.
19. Title holders are required to attend Clements Buckaroos events unless a prior commitment or emergency arises. Title holders must notify the Queen Coordinator immediately if they are unable to attend a required event.
20. Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 10 PRCA rodeos and 5 parades during their reign. Required events include: Folsom Rodeo, Marysville Rodeo, Livermore Rodeo, Motherlode Round-Up Rodeo & Parade, Oakdale Rodeo & Parade, Ripon Almond Blossom Parade, and Galt 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. A full list will be provided. A contact person will be appointed for scheduling and reporting.
21. Teen Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 10 CCPRA rodeos and 5 parades during their reign. Required events include: La Grange Rodeo, Calaveras Rodeo, Amador Rodeo, Motherlode Fair Rodeo, Motherlode Round-Up Parade, Oakdale Rodeo Parade, Ripon Almond Blossom Parade, and Galt 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. A full list will be provided. A contact person will be appointed for scheduling and reporting.
22. Jr. Miss and Little Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 5 junior/high school rodeos and 5 parades during their reign, including Motherlode Round-Up Parade, Oakdale Rodeo Parade, Ripon Almond Blossom Parade, and Galt 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. A contact person will be appointed for scheduling and reporting.
23. Any harassment of the pageant committee, rodeo committee, judges, or other contestants by a contestant or her family will be considered grounds for disqualification from the competition or removal of title.

24. The Miss Clements Stampede chaps and leather sash are perpetual and the property of the Miss Clements Stampede Committee and the Clements Buckaroos. They must be kept in good condition during the reign of the Miss, Teen Miss, Jr. Miss, and Little Miss title holders. If they are not maintained in good condition, they must be replaced at the expense of the title holder. Chaps and leather sash must be relinquished at the end of the reign or at the request of the Miss Clements Stampede Committee.
25. **Failure to adhere to any of the Miss Clements Stampede Contest Rules and Regulations may result in dismissal from the contest or removal of title.**

A committee contact will be assigned to assist with scheduling and reporting for all events. A full list of approved events will be provided. Specific events will be coordinated through the committee contact person.

Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 10 rodeos and 5 parades during their reign.

## **Teen Miss Requirements**

Teen Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 10 rodeos and 5 parades during their reign.

- La Grange Rodeo
- Calaveras Rodeo
- Amador Rodeo
- Motherlode Fair Rodeo
- Motherlode Round-Up Parade
- Oakdale Rodeo Parade
- Ripon Almond Blossom Parade
- Galt 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade

## **Jr. Miss & Little Miss Requirements**

Jr. Miss and Little Miss title holders are required to attend a minimum of 5 junior/high school rodeos and 5 parades during their reign.

Required Events Include:

- Motherlode Round-Up Parade
- Oakdale Rodeo Parade
- Ripon Almond Blossom Parade
- Galt 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade
- Approved junior rodeos
- High school rodeo events
